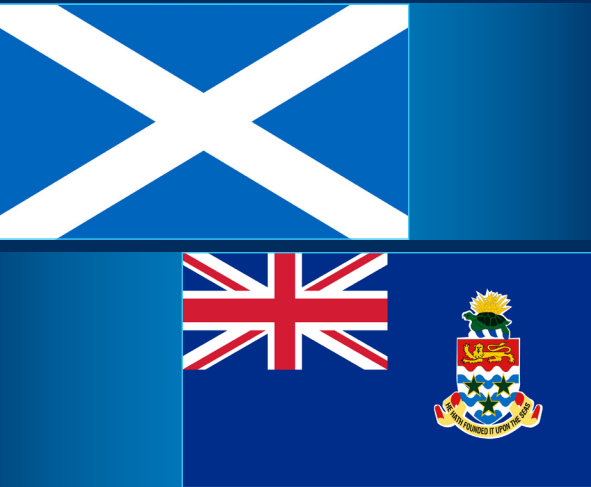
# Our Goals

The Choir and Concert Band have performed at the annual Rotary Club Christmas Tree Lighting, the Choirs often sing during school Masses and also for Parish events such as Confirmation and First Holy Communion. Students also participate in the Orchestra at the annual School Musical Production.

The Swing Band are regularly asked to perform at corporate and fundraising events across Cayman.

Soloists perform at the local National Children’s Festival of the Arts and have had a lot of success in the Young Musician of the Year Competition.

For the past 3 years St Ignatius Concert band and High School Choir have participated in the Private Schools Festival and benefitted from the instruction of world renown musical professionals.
